RESPECT

- Consumption of drugs or alcohol is forbidden at all times.
- Consumption of energy drinks is not tolerated.
- No form of violence, bullying or vandalism is tolerated.
- Language must be appropriate and polite at all times.
- Mutual respect is essential between FNEC employees, officials, community supervisors, chaperones, coaches, and participants.

CLEANLINESS OF THE SITE

- Laval University and the hotel, where applicable, must be left in the same condition as when they were found. This includes student residences, rooms, cafeterias, gymnasiums, hallways, stands, showers, and washrooms.
- All garbage must be placed IN a garbage can. If a garbage can is full, garbage must be discarded in another garbage can.

ACCOMODATIONS

- Curfew is set at 10:00 p.m. and at 10:30 p.m. on Saturday, May 25.
- Laval University will be staffed by security officers around the clock to ensure the safety and well-being of everyone. Their instructions must be heeded.

WARNING

- Anyone who consumes or has consumed drugs or alcohol during the Inter-school Games will be immediately ejected.
- Communities agree to take full responsibility for the actions and conduct of every individual from their delegation, and to reimburse any repair costs related to the incidents.
- Depending on the seriousness of the incident, the community in question may receive a penalty and a one-year suspension from participating in the Inter-school Games."
